

Classes of Information held by the Electricity Regulatory Authority

A Class of Information is a method of collecting together similar types of information. The Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA) has grouped its Classes of Information into broad categories by **function** which reflect the ERA's major areas of responsibility.

The main **operational functions** of the ERA are:

1. Licensing Electricity Generation, Transmission and Distribution

The ERA holds records relating to this function grouped alphabetically under the following headings:

- Advising
- Dispute Resolution
- Enforcement
- Granting Licences
- Guidance
- Monitoring of existing licenses
- Research and Development
- Tendering

2. Regulating Electricity Generation, Transmission and Distribution

The ERA holds records relating to this function grouped alphabetically under the following headings:

- Advising
- Complaints related to electricity providers licensed by the ERA
- Enforcement
- Guidance
- Monitoring
- Policy
- Promoting the use of Renewables
- Research and Development

The main **administrative functions** of the ERA on which the ERA holds records are as follows:

1. Financial Management
2. Human Resources Management
3. Information Management
4. Secretariat Support
5. Strategic Management
